- June 5 (Tuesday) – Cultural day in San Salvador: Fernando Llor's workshop and gallery, lunch and tour at coffee cooperative in Santiago Texacuangos, afternoon at the El Tunco beach
- June 6 (Wednesday) – Delegation returns to USA
